

b) Relaxation for wards of working or retired or deceased (except dismissed, compulsory retired or removed from service) Chandigarh Police employees as under:

- i) 2 years relaxation for wards of Serving and retired (living or deceased) employees
- ii) 3 years relaxation for wards of those who died in service

c) Departmental candidates of Chandigarh Police upto 40 years as on 15.6.2023

(ii) **Minimum Educational Qualification:**

Graduation or its equivalent from any recognized university.

(iii) **Computer Skills:**

ICT course is mandatory at entry level as per instructions issued by the Chandigarh Administration vide letter No.28/69-IH(12)/Pers. & Trg-2019/17927 dated 25.11.2019.

Relevant paragraphs from aforesaid instructions are reproduced below:

" i) The following ICT Skills courses are mandatory for all fresh recruitments (Entry Level) and for promotions/grant of benefit under Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACPS) to all Group 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D' employees of the Chandigarh Administration:-

iii) The candidates who have Certificates/Diplomas/Bachelor's OR Master's Degree in Computer Science from any recognized institution/University shall be exempted from ICT Skills training course.

iv) The Candidates at entry level will submit the certificates of ICT Skills training Course for the above said duration [Group-wise] from a Govt. recognized institution OR a reputed institution which is an ISO 9001 certified OR Department of Electronics Accreditation of Computer Course (DOEACC), Govt. of India OR from NIELIT and its authorized institutions at the time of their appointments. "

(iv) **Driving Skills (For Male Candidates only):-**

Possession of a valid driving license to drive both, two-wheelers and four-wheeler vehicles, is mandatory for male candidates of all categories as on the date of submission of online application.

Note: Collection charges or processing fees charged by the bank, payable by the candidates, shall be in addition to application fee as above payable to Chandigarh Police.

5. **Criteria for Selection, Examination & Syllabus:-**

- 5.1. All candidates [including ex-servicemen], shall be put through a **Single Examination of two hours** duration consisting of **TWO Tiers: Tier I - OMR Sheet Based Test (50 Marks)** and **Tier II Written Test (50 Marks)** as per details given below.
- 5.2. OMR Sheet-Based Test (Tier I) will consist of 50 Multiple choice objective type questions on General Knowledge/Current Affairs, I.T. Knowledge, IQ, Reasoning, Numerical Ability and Ethics. Each question will carry one mark for every correct answer and a negative marking of 0.25 for every wrong answer.
- 5.3. Written Test (Tier II) shall be subjective and shall include questions on:

- 5.4. The minimum qualifying cut off Marks in the Tier-I paper shall be 33% for all categories.
- 5.5. Only those Candidates who score the above mentioned minimum qualifying marks in Tier-I Test shall be eligible for evaluation of their Tier-II Test. However, the Director General of Police shall reserve the right to change the minimum qualifying cut off marks if sufficient number of candidates are not qualifying the Tier-I paper in all/any category, with reasons to be recorded in writing. Shortlisted candidates after written test will be called for PE&MT @10 times of each category of candidates in merit order.
- 5.6. The question paper for the Tier-I and Tier-II Test shall be in Hindi, English and Punjabi. Each candidate will be given the test paper only in the language selected by the candidate during the online application process. Change of medium will not be permitted.

6. Physical Efficiency & Measurement Test (PE&MT):-

PE&MT as per following minimum standards will be conducted for candidates who are shortlisted after the Written Test:-

All candidates appearing for PE&MT shall be subjected to a dope test.

7. **Bonus Marks**

(i) In line with the instructions of Govt. of India, incentives to NCC Certificate holder will be granted in the form of marks as under:-

Weightage will be given to the Candidate in form of 'Marks' who is Graduate from the Rashtriya Raksha University (RRU), Gandhinagar (Gujrat). This additional mark will be provided @2% of total marks to Graduates of RRU.

The final merit list for each category shall be based on the outcome of the total marks obtained in the written examination (Total marks of Tier-I and Tier-II tests) and the bonus marks as above, for those who qualify in PE&MT.
